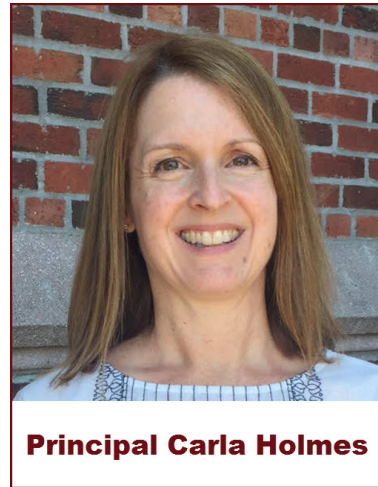

It is the second RULER tool used for self-awareness to help us recognize how we feel, and recognize our own and other's emotions. She comes to us with extensive experience as an ELL (English Language Learning) teacher and facilitator, as well as more recently as a private literacy intervention teacher. 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## Watch For Symptoms: Mumps Outbreak

Dear Bagley Community,

As you may know, several cases of mumps are showing up in King County. Please watch your students closely for signs and symptoms, including:

- fever
- headache
- muscle aches
- tiredness
- loss of appetite
- and/or swollen, tender salivary glands under the ears on one or both sides



If you notice these in your student, please contact their health care provider. Fortunately, students who have been vaccinated are far less likely to get mumps, and if they do, are less likely to have a severe case. Please ensure that your student has been thoroughly vaccinated.

Be advised: there is a possibility that if a case occurs in our school community, students who have not been fully vaccinated may need to be excluded from school for at least 25 days for their own and the community's safety.

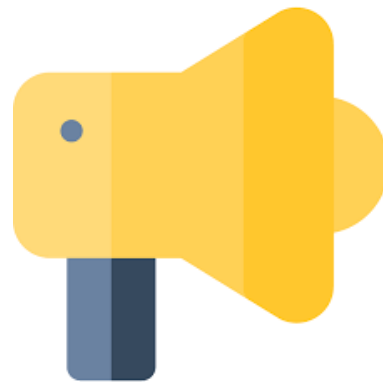
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## Reminder: WA Capital Rally

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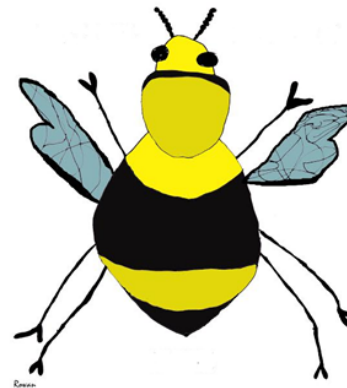
