**Spanish Novice Low****Grades K-2nd****\$175**

Art, music, drama and games guide the curriculum for our Spanish classes. Since our focus is on oral proficiency, classes are conducted entirely in the target language so that students are fully engaged in the language and culture they are studying. Novice Low is generally a K-2nd grade class of first time Spanish students. By the end of the school year, these students will be able to understand some high-frequency words and expressions, mainly greetings, related to introductions and some basic memorized vocabulary. They will be able to introduce themselves and perform some basic verbs when prompted.

**Spanish Novice Mix****Grades 3rd - 5th****\$193**

Art, music, drama and games guide the curriculum for our Spanish classes. Our focus is on oral proficiency and classes are conducted entirely in the target language so that students are fully engaged in the language and culture they are studying. Novice Mid is generally a 3rd-5th grade class of first and second year Mandarin students. By the end of the school year, students will be able to share short learned phrases about themselves, their families and their surroundings. Listeners can recognize and use a number of high-frequency, highly contextualized words and phrases. Typically, they can understand one phrase at a time, and repetition may be required.

**Word Magic - Creative Writing****All Grades****\$255**

Inspire your child's communication and writing skills! Word Magic is a creative writing club where students explore comic strip creation, word games, free writing, poetry, haiku, guided writing activities, short stories, songwriting and sharing throughout each session. Using games and group and activities, students learn about literary devices (such as onomatopoeia, alliteration, personification, simile and metaphor, story construction, and more.) The session ends with a reading open to parents and friends.
